BEST PRACTICE 1 :

1) TITLE OF THE PRACTICE: FREE ADMISSION TO STUDENTS

GOAL OBJECTIVES:

- To extend free financial assistance to Final year students during Covid-19 Pandemic Period for admission in 2021-22 and 2022-23.
- 2. To ensure that no Final Year student is deprived of his/her admission.
- To collect contribution (money) from each faculty members for providing free admission to students.
- 4. To extend a helping hand to students.

2) OBJECTIVES OF THE PRACTICE:

The main objectives are listed below:

- Money is important in every -day life. Poor and needy students must get financial help from their teachers during natural calamities like Covid-19 pandemic years.
- Providing free financial assistance to students for admission.
- Ensuring that no student is deprived of his /her admission opportunity for want of money.
- > Raising a common fund (money) from the donations/contribution of faculty members.
- Appealing the students to approach their respective teachers for free financial assistance.
- Securing free admission to the class from the contribution of teachers.

Our college students suffered a lot from this epidemic disaster. Most of our students come from the poor strata of society. Most of our students work during day time. They do it so that their livelihood and pocket money for education is ensured. They are really hard working. They are sincere. It is very sad to state that they lost their part time jobs on which they heavily relied, was lost. They were out of jobs. They had no money to secure admission in college. So all staff members decided to collect a fund from their monthly salary and help them in their hard times.

Students were requested to fill up a form sharing their full name, class, year and previous details of exams etc. It was a very simple method. They were given the required amount for free admission, After the HODs sign, their admission was done.

3) The Context:

In the higher education, research has got the prime significance in the policy of Govt. of India. The college has taken initiative in this direction to imbibe the research culture among the teachers and students. The college has created a platform for research talents among the students. The college organizes academic and other activities regularly. To publicize these activities, the college has started its own news i. e Sanjvat magazine and the college organized National Webinars.

4) The Practice:

The college has Sanjvat (a College Magazine) for students since the beginning of the college. Students write their own poetry and it is pasted in the Sanjvat. The college also publishes Sanjvat Magazine every year. There is an Editorial Board for the magazine, which works under the Chairmanship of the Principal. The students are encouraged to write poems and other articles. The teachers are also encouraged to write research articles in reputed journals. 04 faculty members are recognized Ph. D. Research Supervisors. More than 90 percent teachers are PhD holders in their own subject and the teachers are also motivated to apply for research projects.

5) Evidence of Success:

It is noticed that due to the *Sanjvat* Magazine the research culture among the students is boosted. 07 faculty members successfully awarded their Ph. D during five year and now there are 12 teachers who are Ph.D holders and 01 M. Phil holder. Teachers published 109 research papers in reputed journals and in UGC Care listed journals 15 research papers in the last five years. The number of research articles presented in the national/international seminars/conferences has been considerably increased.

6) Problems Encountered and Resources Required:

In the initial stage of the publication of the journal, there was no adequate number of research articles for publication. Our Principal Dr A N Barbole encouraged and motivated to staff members and students for writing research articles. So due to the consistency in publication, there is good response from the researchers.

Our Principal Dr A N Barbole encouraged and motivated to staff members and students for writing research articles. So due to the consistency in publication, there is good response from the researchers.
